Details of the faulty joining, relieving, department credentials, centralized valuation must be carried out in the timely manner through the university portal.all the grades and information regardin appointing as examiner are made available through university portal only.

The college must use Naan Muthalvan portal to provide placement , placement training, value added courses and provide training to the faculty members who are allocated to handle Naan Muthalvan courses. This is mandatory for all the UG students of Tamilnadu, offered by Tamilnadu state government. The scholarship of state and other metrics are applied in the government portal only. The state government offers various scholarship like sc/st, minority, Puthumai pen for girls and Tamil puthalvan for boys etc. It can be applied in the particular portal only.

- ❖ The college website will be updated regularly to showcase college developments and provide information to all stakeholders.
- ❖ Adopted and implemented e-governance in maximum areas of operation entered into an agreement with an ERP vendor and provided efficient system of governance within the institution
- ❖ Student Admission: The College processes admissions for all programmes made available through online mode.

- ❖ Administration: Facilities for online leave management of employees, e copy of salary certificates, booking of venues, internal communication are processed through e-governance.
- ❖ Examination: As per the directions of the Affiliating University, the institution follows the ERP module for examination purpose
- ❖ Alumni: In order to strengthen alumni interaction, a separate alumni portal is provided with registration, information of the college activities, list of prominent alumni, achievements of the alumni and feedback.
- ❖ All staff member has to comply with biometric scanning to ensure the transparency in attendance.
